

## Welcome to Green Island

Located at the confluence of the McKenzie and the Willamette Rivers, Green Island contains some of the least altered fish and wildlife habitats in the Willamette Valley. Protected in 2003 by McKenzie River Trust, this area provides essential habitat for many birds.

This area has been slowly reforested and provides a range of habitats. As the area grows toward a more natural state, we will likely see changes in the types of birds using the land and water here. You can help us to document these changes over time by visiting during our open days and logging your observations in eBird.
